Till The Stars Turn Cold, Sheffield

The exhibition's romantic title is taken from a line in the 1952 film *Singing In The Rain* – “Our love will last till the stars turn cold” – which, in the film's plot, is dubbed by stand-in Debbie Reynolds due to the leading actress Jean Hagen's discordant original delivery. This show's six artists dance around the theme of intriguing audiovisual mismatches and productive mistranslations. Kathryn Elkin is bound to shine with her amusing monologue performances of faulty transcriptions and tenuous cross-associations, as is Josh Kline whose photos explore apparent contradictions. So the web is woven: out of technical misfortunes might come creative magic.
